# **English**

This term in English we will be learning around our Topic: Crime and Punishment. With the support of Steventon Parish Council and the local MP, the children will gain an understanding of how different levels of democracy work. Through the poem 'The Highwayman', they will learn about crime and punishment throughout history to the modern day. Activities will include role playing and debating.

# **Humanities**

In Art, they will experiment in using line, tone, shape and colour to reflect mood and emotion. This will be created with different medias including watercolour. They will design and create Waymarkers reflecting the Highwayman.

In RE the children will be learning about Sikhism, and the commitments that Sikhs they make to show their beliefs.

## **Maths**

This term in Maths we will continue to follow the White Rose Scheme of Learning. We will cover Place Value including 1000s, 100s, 10s and 1s, number lines to 1, 000 and 10,000, comparing numbers and rounding. We will also start work on addition and subtraction. Wherever possible, we will relate this to our topic of 'Crime and Punishment'.

# **Uniform, PE and kit**

Children should come to school in named uniform with school shoes, not trainers. They should bring a named water bottle every day.
