I am always so proud to be the Headteacher of our school — never more so than when members of the public contact school to congratulate our children on their conduct at events such as the Act of Remembrance and the Poppy Trail. Thank you to those of you who responded to the parent questionnaire about the Christmas Service. Rev. Phil and I have worked closely to make sure this can happen at the church this year, to find creative ways of seating the children and see how we can enable as many parents to attend as possible. We are also looking at ways we can record the service for those parents who are unable to attend due to work commitments. 
