Fox - Red


Dormouse - Yellow Barn Owl - Blue Hedgehog - Green

# **Transition Days**

This year, the children will be meeting their new teachers on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July. They will spend the day getting to know them and the new class teacher will see them out at the end of the day. There will be an opportunity for parents to come into the classrooms and informally meet the teachers straight after school on the same day.

### **Reports**

Annual reports will come home on **Friday 14**<sup>th</sup> **July**. This year we have taken the decision to change the report format being sent home to parents. Taking on board the feedback from the parent survey regarding knowing how well your child is achieving, alongside our focus on the Foundation subjects, we have produced a format that is hopefully much more informative.

You will see that for each subject, your child's attainment level is shared.

Greater Depth	Pupils working beyond the standard expected for their year group, showing greater depth of understanding.
Age Related	Pupils who are working at the standard expected for their year group.
Working Towards	Pupils working at the appropriate age curriculum, but who have not yet secured all the expected learning for their year group.
Below	Pupils who are not yet working on the objectives linked to their year group.

We have brought all year groups in line with the terminology used in Year 2 and Year 6 with the statutory assessment points.

We hope that parents will find this easier to understand and see the progress their children have made.

You will also receive information regarding your child's attendance as well as their general behaviour and effort. Children who have completed statutory assessments eg SATs, Multiplication Timetable Check, Phonics Screening Check or Early Years Foundation Stage, you will receive your child's results within the annual report.
